PLAN TO CELEBRATE WITH US ON OCTOBER 22!


he theme for Birthright's festive gala and fundraiser, slated for October 22 at the Fredericksburg Country Club, is "Celebrating Forty Years of Loving Them Both." Dedicated volunteers and faithful benefactors, along with friends both old and new, are invited to renew acquaintances and reminisce about Fredericksburg's first pro-life service organization that was born in 1976.

Irene Hagerty, who was then president of the Council of Catholic Women (CCW) at St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception Church in Fredericksburg, along with some like-minded members, was inspired to inaugurate a local chapter of Birthright, an international, interdenominational group founded in Toronto in 1968 by the late Louise Summerhill to help women facing an unplanned pregnancy.

Irene became the first director and held that position for an unbelievable twenty-five years! Donna Hart succeeded Irene and remains active today as a client advocate and president of the board of directors. Maria Cackett and Mary Thorsted became co-directors and were later succeeded by Carolyn Brodeur and Amanda Pulley. Barbara Carr and Betsy Flanigan later took over the reins as co-directors and both remain active today performing a variety of duties.

Currently, Lily Alarcon leads the organization. Like all her predecessors in the director position, Lily does this work out of the goodness of her heart; she is a smart, dynamic, hardworking leader whose talents would be richly rewarded in the workplace.

Our all-volunteer office is located at 2006 Lafayette Boulevard in the Paul's Bakery complex where we have



welcomed an average of 1,000 women each year from all localities in Planning District 16. Our client advocates administer over 800 pregnancy tests yearly. Mother and child -loving them both - is always the focus as we fulfill the mission statement of our international organization: "It is the right of every pregnant woman to give birth and the right of every child to be born."

To help us celebrate that theme and to raise some much needed funds to continue our work, gala organizers have lined up some impressive speakers as well as some donations of outstanding original art from both local professional artists along with some student art which will be available for purchase.

Serrin Foster, president of Feminists for Life (FFL) in Alexandria, will be the main presenter. Her landmark speech, "The Feminist Case Against Abortion," has been recognized as one of the "great speeches in history" in the anthology called Women's Rights. The leader of FFL since 1994, Foster has successfully advocated for women and children on countless university campuses, on Capitol Hill, and in major media outlets. She served on the National Taskforce Against Sexual Assault and Domestic Violence which worked to pass the Violence Against Women Act. Serrin's mom was an early Birthright volunteer. Attendees will learn how Serrin's mother influenced her work for FFL today.

Christopher Rooney of Fredericksburg will keep the festivities rolling along as master of ceremonies for the event.

Jessica was already mother to a special needs 9-year-old son and two 'angel' babies who have been miscarried. Now being pregnant, she voiced her hope that this might be her 'rainbow' baby. She was 19 years old when she conceived her son. Doctors and friends had told her to have an abortion because he was diagnosed with severe handicaps. She refused to abort her child, whom she named Chance, aware of the 'chance' she was taking, since he would likely be severely handicapped. He now has a trach, a g-tube, and scoliosis, which requires surgery every six months to straighten his spine as he grows. Despite these limits, Jessica went on to describe him as the most loving, caring child anyone could ever meet. She has no regrets for choosing to give life to Chance and is excited to welcome another child. Motherhood isn't about 'taking chances' but about receiving the blessings of life.
